



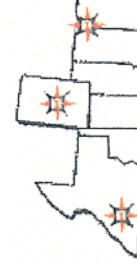

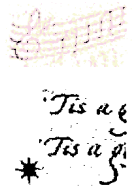

The younger son of Julius and Ethel Rosenberg will be speaking in **Boulder April 11 at the First Methodist Church on the corner of 14th and Spruce**, and in **Denver on April 12 at the First Mennonite Church on the corner of 9th and Elati**. Both talks begin at 7pm. His talk is entitled "Capital Conspiracy" and he will speak on the similarities between the era in which his parents were murdered by the government on conspiracy charges of treason, and today's post-9.11 world. He will be collecting donations for his organization, the Roseburg Fund for Children, which has granted over one million dollars to help children of targeted political

AFSC Staff Person Minsun Ji will be one of two presenters in a workshop on immigration and immigrant labor issues on **Friday April 19 from 3:00 - 4:45 PM at Bethany Lutheran Church, 4500 E. Hampden, in Englewood.** Minsun will be speaking about our project with day laborers. This workshop is part of a larger conference on Hispanic Ministries organized by an interdenominational committee.

There will be a jointly sponsored (including AFSC) peace march in Denver on **Saturday, April 20, beginning at 2:00 PM.** The theme for the march is, "Stop All War." Participants will be asked to commit to a code of nonviolence. The march will begin at the Federal Court House at 19th and Stout. The exact route is still being determined, but a good portion of it will be along the 16th street mall, ending close to 16th and Broadway. All are invited to participate. You can help plan this event, by coming to a planning meeting at the AFSC office on Thursday, April 11 at 7:00 PM. Your contribution is valued!

Jubilee Colorado is helping to bring the movie "Life & Debt" to Colorado.
